Gerakan Pramuka hosted remarkable workshop in Bogor

Three themes set the tone of the APR Workshop on Communications and Marketing in Bogor, Indonesia: understanding quality practices, creating impact and growing membership. Gerakan Pramuka hosted forty-five local and overseas participants from 13 countries at the scenic town of Bogor.

Participants shared quality practices of their NSOs and thought-provoking sessions were delivered on membership growth challenges, how to make Scouting more appealing to young people, creating impact through various channels such as social media, digital media and Scouting events, developing a communications strategy, and handling management crisis.

Different levels of Scouting were represented at this workshop with resource persons and facilitators from the APR Scouting Profile Sub-Committee, the World Scout Bureau and communication experts from Maverick Indonesia.

International Seminar on Scouts of the World Award

A total of 38 international and local participants from 16 NSOs attended the workshop. The seminar aims to share with NSOs the technical process of developing the Scouts of the World Programme and revitalize the programme of Senior and Rover Sections. Some NSOs shared how they successfully implemented the SW.

More than a month after launching the Scout Photo Community and the Scout Photo Missions Contest in partnership with PicHit.me, WOSM has received over 2,000 photos from Scouts from at least 80 countries across all six Scout regions – Africa, Arab, Asia Pacific, Eurasia, Europe and Interamerica.

All together, these photo stories create a culturally diverse puzzle, which reveals the essence of the Scout movement. They are not just simple images, but inspiring grassroots' narratives, describing incredible moments and experiences lived during Scout activities throughout the world.

New Messengers Of Peace Heroes Awarded in Saudi Arabia

Scouts, Scout leaders as well as National Scout Organizations from different parts of the world were awarded with the Messengers of Peace Hero Award 2014 during the recent Saudi National Day celebration in Ha'il, Saudi Arabia.

The Award, conceived in 2012, is a special recognition from the Saudi Arabia Government to individual Scouts or National Scout Organizations (NSOs) for all the outstanding work they have been doing to create a better and more peaceful world.

During this third presentation, awardees from all the six regions - Africa, Arab, Asia-Pacific, Eurasia, Europe and Interamerica - were distinguished for their remarkable peace initiatives at local, national and regional levels. From relief operations after devastating floods to sustainable environmental activities in 33 countries all over the world, their projects have contributed to raise awareness and foster areas such as peace culture, social entrepreneurship, environment and emergency relief. These Scouts are true examples of active citizens working for positive changes in their communities.

Since 2012, Scouts have already registered over 584 million service hours inspired by World Scouting's initiatives such as Messengers of Peace, Scouts of the World and the World Scout Environment Programme. All the efforts have helped create a global network of service envisioned by Baden-Powell as a place "where young citizens, male and female in all

4th Forestry Special Troop National Scout Camp

Who: Rovers and Senior Scouts between 18 to 25 years old, male and female. NSOs in the Asia-Pacific Region are invited to send 8 male and 8 female Rovers/Senior Rovers and also 2 leaders (male & female).

When: 15 – 20 December 2014. Participants are requested to arrive at the campsite on 14th December 2014 or 15th December 2014 morning and leave the campsite on 21st December 2014.

Where: Cibubur National Scout Campsite, Jakarta. Weather is generally hot with average temperature from 26 to 31°C. It will be rainy season during the event.

Fee: US\$150 per person to cover food for seven days, transport from Soekarno Hatta International Airport in Jakarta to the campsite and back, accommodation in tents, camp kit (scarf, bag, handbook, cap, shirt) and activities.

Who: Scouts aged between 12-17 years old

When: 16-23 December 2014. Participants are requested to arrive on 16th December before noon and may leave on 23rd December 2014.

Theme: Peace Through Scouting

Fee: SAARC Countries – no registration fee. Other than SAARC countries – US\$100

Airport Arrangement: Participants traveling by air will be received at Jinnah International Airport Karachi & Sukkur. Other participants will be received at the entry points in Sukkur/Khairpur Mirs with prior arrangement.

Weather: Khairpur Mirs will be slightly cold in December. Temperature will be around 25°C daytime and 15°Cs at night. Warm clothes will be required.
