Myanmar Scouts joins WOSM

The World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM) welcomes Myanmar Scouts -- the National Scout Organization of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar. WOSM currently has a total of 164 National Scout Organizations in more than 220 countries and territories around the world.

Scouting was introduced in Myanmar since the 1950s and was disbanded in 1964. Membership before disbandment was over 100,000. Since the redevelopment of Scouting started in 2012, current membership is approximately 25,000.

The Union of Burma Boy Scouts was a full member of the World Organization of the Scout Movement in the early 1950s. They were active and had complied with their constitutional duties.

Scouting in Myanmar (Burma) was disbanded in 1964 due to change in the government system. In the decades following, Scouting units existed underground and the firm believers of the Principles of Scouting continued the programme. This was evident when the regional team met old Scouts who continued the same Scouting methods. This is further manifested by the existence of their Scouting manuals, records, and uniform.

The legal registration and Constitution of Myanmar Scouts was approved by the Myanmar government. The Constitutions Committee, on behalf of the World Scout Committee, confirmed that all requirements of WOSM membership under Chapter III, Article V have been fulfilled. *From scout.org*

Scout Method revisited

Revisiting the Scout Method is a way to encourage National Scout Organizations re-emphasize the World Youth Programme Policy in their activities and projects, taking into consideration the outcomes of the 1st World Scout Education Congress held in 2013.

The Asia-Pacific Region took the initiative to revisit the Scout Method through a workshop held at Tamkang University in New Taipei City, Taiwan on 12 to 15 August 2016. Forty-five participants from 13 countries came both from APR and other regions.

"The current 7 items of the Scout Method were defined in the 1990s, more than 20 years ago. To help young people face this fast-changing world, it is

Strategic Planning in Timor Leste commenced

The UNE-TL workshop for designing the National Strategic Plan started on Monday, 29th of August, with the opening ceremony held at the Peony Hotel in Dili.

Amongst the 45 participants are the key Scout Leaders from UNE-TL, young Scouts and group leaders from various municipalities. Resource persons from Scouts Australia Mr. Chris Bates and Peter Blatch, Asia-Pacific Support Centre Prassanna Shrivastava are supporting the drafting of the National Strategic plan. Leaders from UNE-TL are part of the workshop team facilitators.

The opening ceremony was officially opened by the National Director of Secretary of State for Youth and Sports, representing HE Secretary of State accompanied by UNE-TL President Ms Idelta Rodrigues. Among the attendees of the opening ceremony was the representative of Partner for Human Development (PHD) and the acting Ambassador of Australia Ms Joannah Leahy who also addressed in her remarks the importance of contributing to the youth activities and non-formal education for youth.

The workshop will last for four days and participants are expected to actively participate in the discussions and identify key areas where UNE-TL would play a role in contributing to the state building processes. Few key agendas are finding the key strength and weakness, determining the key strategic priorities areas and formulating the Vision for the UNE-TL.

Gerakan Pramuka officially applies the Wood Badge framework

For so long, Gerakan Pramuka used its own symbol for adult leaders who pass the Wood Badge Advanced Course. Now, Gerakan Pramuka made it official to use the Wood Badge Framework – two beads for those who pass the Advanced Course, three beads for the Course for Assistant Leader Trainer (CALT) and then four beads for Course for Leader Trainer (CLT) participants who complete the action plan.

The inauguration of using again the Wood Badge was held at the first Indaba and first Gilwell Reunion, which was held at Cibubur Campsite on 20th August 2016. The activity comprised the adult leaders who accompanied their contingents to the Indonesia 10th National Scout Jamboree, held at the same place, from 14 to 21 August 2016.

Dr Susi Yuliati, Vice Chairperson for Adults in Scouting represented the Chairman of Gerakan Pramuka in giving the Wood Badge to 13 Leader Trainers. *with thanks to Berthold Sinaulan*
