The following information will help you to be "Prepared" for the course:

Travel and Transportation:

Each participant is responsible for their personal transportation to Marina del Rey, California. If you are traveling by air, we recommend you use the Los Angeles International airport (LAX). Uniform:

You should have at least one full uniform appropriate for your current position with correct insignia. Unlike previous Wood Badge courses, participants will not need to remove any existing official insignia from their uniforms. Activities uniforms such as the Scout T-shirt and Polo shirt will be worn with the official Scout short or pants.

Equipment List:

This course will be an intensive leadership development experience, which will include both training center and camping environments. It will feature a two-night camp out on the beach (Wednesday-Friday). While at Camp Emerald Bay, you will stay in summer camp type tents on wooden platforms. Cots will also be provided (See enclosed "What to Bring" equipment list).
